

**McIntosh Reserve Park  
Wedding Rules/Guidelines  
2009**

1. Birdseed is preferable to rice. Please no confetti.
2. No parking in or alongside of roadway.
3. No parking within 25 ft. of Chief's gravesite.
4. All signs and decorations must be removed after wedding.
5. No signs, balloons, etc. nailed to trees, or tied or taped to park signage.
6. It is the wedding party's responsibility to know the opening and closing hours of the park.
7. No more than 30 guests including the wedding party on the overlook platform or 25 on log cabin porches at any time. No open fires at log cabin or river overlook
8. No lewd or rude conduct, loud music, or rowdy behavior.
9. All receptions must be planned separate from the wedding ceremony. No receptions on overlook or inside log cabin.
10. Please limit decorations on cars that could blow off of while traveling through park.
11. Charges for facilities re: wedding ceremony \$45 - \$65 for weddings not exceeding 75 guests.  
Charges for facilities re: wedding reception \$25 - \$50  
Deposit: \$50
  - Rehearsals and set-up prior to wedding date may result in extra charges and should be pre-arranged at the same time reservations are made.
  - All weddings exceeding 75 people will be assessed additional fees to cover parking, etc.
  - All facilities in the park are designed for 100 people or less. Keep this in mind when planning your wedding. Larger weddings can make use of fields and other scenic areas, see staff for details.
12. All guests are subject to park rules, plus state & federal laws.
13. No tent, tables or other rental items may be placed at facilities without the park's approval. The park will not be responsible for any items left by wedding party. When placing said items, no tents may be set up in public thoroughways, i.e. the yards of the log cabin; anywhere blocking public trails or entry to public buildings is prohibited.
14. Any tables moved during a reception must be returned to their original positions under the picnic shelters.
15. Wedding deposits will be refunded the first Monday after your wedding providing there are no damages to the facilities used, all other fees have been paid, and all tables, decorations, etc. are removed or put back in place.
